Paul Coghlin is a multi award-winning photographer based in Suffolk. His expressive photography responds very sensitively to his understanding of the environment. He studied Environmental Science at Plymouth and holds an environment-related Post-Graduate Diploma from University College London. He is an Associate Member of the British Institute of Professional Photography.

2010 was a phenomenal year for Paul

- He became **BIPP Photographer of the Year** and won 7 individual gold and silver awards in the same competition in various subject categories.
- He won third place in the prestigious **FEP European Fine Art Photograph of the Year Award 2010**.
- He was awarded both the “**Photographer of the Year**” and “**Digital Printer of the Year**” in the international B+W Photography Magazine’s annual competition.
- He is also a Second Prize and Honourable Mention Winner in the prestigious le Prix de la Photographie Paris (Px3) competition.
- In addition he has gained seven Honourable Mention Awards in the New York-based International Photography Awards, in a variety of categories.

He produces evocative and abstract monochromes and colour studies of the natural world and our surroundings. The images are achieved through a carefully balanced blend of tones, textures and often very long-exposures. Many of his pieces feature a single prominent colour in an object or region of the photograph. His aim is to produce innovative photographs in a medium we can too easily take for granted. Paul’s patience and attention to detail takes nothing for granted. 2011 is proving to be another successful year for Paul. He won 2nd and 3rd place in this year’s **International Photography Awards** in the Professional category along with three honourable mentions.
